

Administrative Regulation — The President’s Council

I. Charge

As set out in *Governing Regulation VI — The President’s Council*, the council will advise the University President on important issues to the University.

A. Membership

As set out in *Governing Regulation VI — The President’s Council*, membership will include the University President and 12 members from University students, faculty and staff.

1. Composition

The council will be composed of 12 members. Students, faculty and staff will each be represented by four (4) members, selected as described below.

As set out in *Governing Regulation VI — The President’s Council*, there will be three (3) seats occupied by the elected leader of each shared governance body — the Student Government Association, the Faculty Senate and the Staff Senate.

There will be three (3) seats representing an additional elected member of each shared governance body, chosen by the University President from a list of five (5) names submitted to the University President from each shared governance body.

There will be three (3) seats representing a student member, a faculty member and a staff member who are not elected members of their respective shared governance bodies, chosen by the University President from a list of five (5) names submitted to the University President from each shared governance body.

There will be three (3) seats representing a student member, a faculty member and a staff member chosen by the University President.

2. Term

As set out in *Governing Regulation VI — The President’s Council*, members will serve for one year and may be reappointed by the University President.

II. Functions

The functions of the President’s Council are described in *Governing Regulation VI — The President’s Council*.

III. Meetings

The University President will determine the council's meeting cadence, agendas and component items, as needed.
